She was born on June 9, 1939 in Union City, N.J. to the late Raffaella and Pasquale Falchetto. She grew up in Union City and graduated from Kearny High School. When her family moved to Brooklyn she met the future love of her life, Saverio. "He kept calling for a date and finally I said ; let me get rid of this guy and go out with him". On the first date he told me he was going to marry me. I said, "that's what you think". A year and half later they were married on June 21, 1958 in St. Catherine of Sienna Church in Brooklyn. They began their wonderful life together with the births of their children; Ralph, Hope and Xavier. Shortly thereafter they bought a home in Bulls Head and moved to Staten Island.

From 1970 to 1986, along with taking care of her growing family, Adeline was a bookkeeper for the family business taking care of payroll and doing the office work. At the same time, she was a part - time employee at EJ Korvettes in New Springville, working there until 1990, when she retired. She and Severio became "snowbirds" in the winter months when they would travel to Florida.

Adeline was called Honey by her grandchildren and great grandchildren. Honey was an amazing cook and made the best macaroni, meatballs, baked clams and cookies. Even if someone took the exact same recipe, Honey's was always better. She loved to cook, travel, bake, embroider, but most of all spend time with her family. She was always cheering on her grandchildren at dance recitals, sporting events, and graduations. Honey's spirit will live on in her family and friends.
