Arthur was the consummate Jokester of the family, pulling pranks on everyone, he always

had a smile on his face and would ensure that those around him were smiling too.

Arthur most cherished his family above everything, his wife and children were his world, and his shining personality spread outwards to his close and extended family and friends alike.

At the age of 65, after 53 years of smoking, Arthur joined what he considered one of his greatest accomplishments, Nicotine Anonymous, A life long smoker, Arthur finally conquered his vice and in the process built a lasting friendship with his pal Saul Spetler, a relationship he cherished until the end.
