Even when struggling with illness, he was constantly seeking out time with family and friends. He never wanted to miss out on anything, and pursued activities and happiness with his loved ones daily.

Devin was a character. He had the ability to tease and test those around him and then seek out their affection and show sincere concern for their well-being. He was particularly skilled at riling his siblings, Caitlin and Raymond and his grandmother, but desperately sought their attention.

He was a remarkable mix of pure innocence and fierce willfulness. He was the most lovable of noodges.

Devin had so many unique and endearing habits. Some were small, such as his characteristic finger points and an obsession with playing ball in the house. Others were more involved. Devin loved sports and wanted to play or watch them whenever possible. When a spectator, he needed to be in the right jersey. When playing them, every piece of equipment and item of apparel had to be perfectly authentic. Transitioning between sports, when playing with his cousins, always required a wardrobe change.

Devin was a dedicated and passionate fan of the NY Yankees, Giants, Rangers and the Golden State Warriors. However, each year you could depend on him to choose players from the front-runner teams, collect their jerseys and become their most enthusiastic fan.

When he was not ill, he filled every day with activity. He enjoyed eating out, music and vacationing. He connected with everyone he came in contact with: nurses, doctors, teachers and aides. For Devin, life was about who he shared it with.

Devin attended St. Clare, PS 58 and the Hungerford School.

Surviving are his parents, Colleen and Derrick McQueen, brother Raymond Kane, sister Caitlin Kane, grandmother Alice Harrington, nineteen adoring and dedicated cousins and a tremendous extended family.

Despite his illness and limitations, Devin lived life to the fullest. He found happiness in being with others and valued family time above all things. Devin had a smile that radiated joy and his hugs were spectacular. He inspired so many and helped people to appreciate their blessings.

Devin's journey was remarkable and his time here was too short, but his influence was profound and his legacy indelible.
