Although many miles from home, Gerrie never let distance get in the way of speaking with her brothers and remained especially close to her cousin, Daisy Rosario. She enjoyed their conversations over the years and held that true bond that cousins share.

One of Gerrie's greatest loves were her 3 grandsons Andrew, Ryan and Aiden and 1 granddaughter Molly. "Grandma G" loved walking with the kids while they Trick or Treated on Halloween and Thanksgiving and Christmas were always joyous and filled with fun, love and laughter of having the four grandchildren run beside her.

Her latter years were spent in Sea View Nursing Home. Before becoming ill, she spent her time beating her daughter in Scrabble and the card game War. She would laugh at how her grandsons were so mesmerized by the train set in the solarium, time and time again. Her Sundays were spent with her devoted daughter-in-law, grandson and granddaughter listening to music, playing a fierce game of Bingo or doing arts and crafts.
