Sometimes called a 'saint', she was a devout Catholic, praying daily, whose faith carried her through many difficult times before going to be with the Lord.

Josephine was predeceased by her first husband, Frank Andolina in 1989, and her second husband, Adam Elboym in 2000. She is survived by her 3 children, Ida Gephart of Plano, TX, Joseph Andolina of Staten Island, NY and Vincent Andolina of Landsdale, PA. The oldest of 7 children born to the late Ofelia and John Paganica, she is survived by the only remaining sister, Olga Russo of Delray Beach, FL.
