Albert Warren Ahlstrom, passed away on June 4, 2020. He was born and raised in Brooklyn on July 8, 1924. He attended James Madison High School and Brooklyn College where he was in the band and played sports.

Albert entered the U.S. Army in 1943 and served with General McArthur's headquarters as a cryptologist decoding Japanese messages. He was stationed in Australia, Philippines and finally Japan before being discharged in 1946. He returned home and began a career with the NYC Board of Education as a teacher.

Albert met the love of his life, Bernadette Flynn, and together they had 4 sons. They relocated to the Great Kills sections of Staten Island in 1959 and remained there for the rest of his life. Albert became an Assistant Principal and Principal of elementary NYC Public Schools before retiring in 1987. He loved education, music and painting which he passed on to his 4 sons, Dr. Brian Ahlstrom Johnstown, Pa., Michael Ahlstrom, Esquire, Atlanta, Ga., Dr. Albert Ahlstrom Woodstock, Ga. and Captain Joseph Ahlstrom (Professor and NYS Commissioner) Grymes Hill, Staten Island. He also has 5 loving grandchildren, Mathieu, Pierre, Courtney, Emma and Brendan Ahlstrom.

Albert always kept a positive outlook and enjoyed laughing with people. He had a fantastic voice and loved playing the piano while singing; He was an organist and choir director at St Clare Church. Albert loved to paint sing and play the piano which he did until he suffered a stroke and passed away at St University Hospital South where he received excellent care. The day before his stroke Big D took a walk and was heard singing and joking.

Our Dad will be missed by family, friends and neighbors alike.

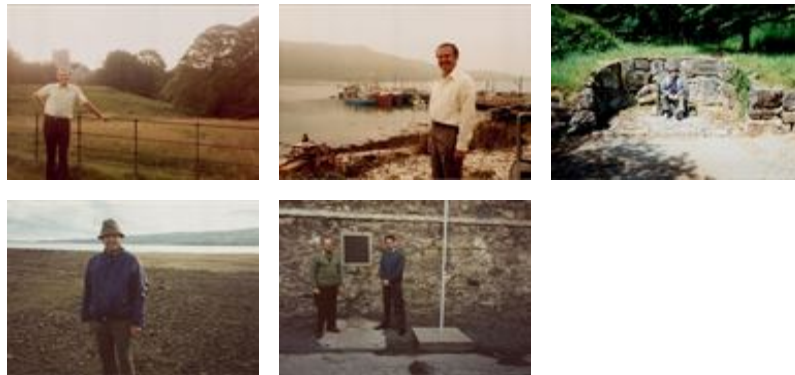
