Alfonse "Mel" Miliano, 84 of Huguenot is remembered as a loving husband, father and grandfather. He passed away on Friday, March 5, 2021 after a long illness.

Alfonse was born and raised in South Beach and a was a graduate of McKee Technical High School. He was one of the last surviving members of the "South Beach Boys." Alfonse later settled in Huguenot about 40 years ago.

Alfonse, better known under his music name as "Mel", was an accomplished jazz guitarist who generously passed his knowledge and love of jazz onto hundreds of students and played with numerous professional jazz artists throughout the years.

He lived for his family and enjoyed spending time with his children and grandchildren.

Alfonse was pre deceased by his loving wife Grace Marie of 47 years.
