Alfred A. Bafumi, 75, of Staten Island, NY, passed away Wednesday April 15th, 2020.

Al was born on July 11, 1944 in Brooklyn, NY to Frank and Frances (Galluzzo) Bafumi. He grew up on East 5th St in the Gravesend neighborhood. He attended Our lady of Grace Elementary school and then Abraham Lincoln High School. Al, a plumber by trade, also worked many years for the Dept. of Environmental Protection for New York City.

Some years after his retirement, Al and Joann tried the country life in Effort, PA. However, the pull of New York City was too much, so they relocated to Staten Island, NY.

Al loved to fish, to target shoot, and the New York Yankees! He would sometimes get into heated disagreements with others if they dared to disparage his team. The disagreements ended with a harrumph and all was good. Furthermore, anyone who knew Al, knew he was a great storyteller. He would regale anyone he was speaking with of his life experiences and how they could help you. Sometimes, these stories would irk his children as they've heard them all before and many times. Al was also a big fan of old

time westerns and movie stars. John Wayne, James Cagney, Elvis Presley and Johnny Cash were some of his favorites.

Al was a product of the 1950s and 60s, however, as he aged and he had grandchildren, he evolved and he became a product of the contemporary world. His grandchildren opened his eyes more than his children ever could.

Al is survived by his loving wife Joann (DeEsposito) of 54 years, his son Frank Bafumi and (Randi) of North Bergen, NJ, his two daughters Francine Scarimbolo (Steven) of Staten Island, NY, and Doreen Patrone (Dominick) of Madison, NJ.

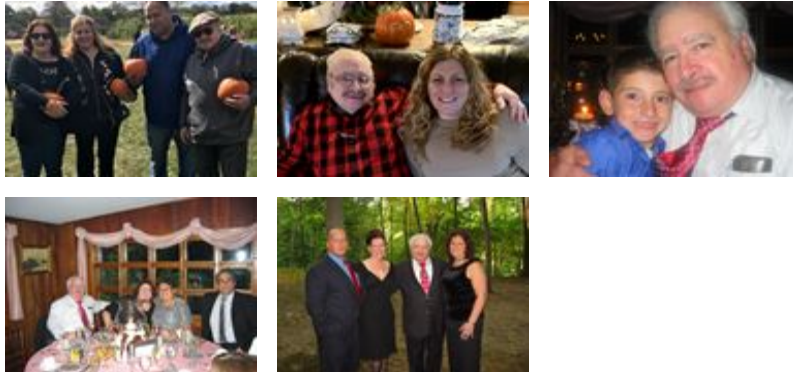

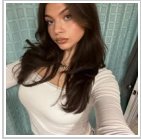
