Coincidentally, the day Angela became a Storm, New York was hit with a blizzard and the couple hardly made it to their honeymoon in Cove Haven Pennsylvania. Angela and Bill's marriage was blessed with two daughters, Andrea and Kerry in 1973 and 1975. In late 1992, Angela was granted guardianship of her nephew, Brian, her sister's only son, and she raised him as her own.
