Ann Buckle passed away on March 4, 2019 in East Northport, New York at the age of 87.

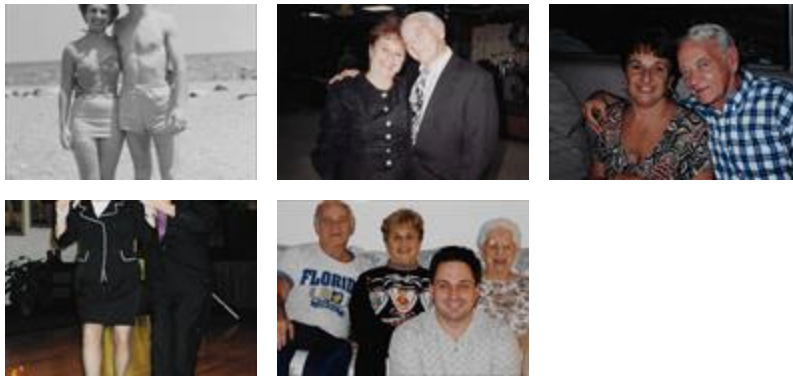
