Anthony Balestrieri, Retired New York City Policer, Age 87 of Huguenot passed away from cancer in the early morning on Thursday Jan 8, 2026.

Anthony was born to Louis and Joesphine Balestrieri in Brooklyn NY on May 6, 1938.

A Graduate of Manual Training High School in 1955, he excelled in baseball where they won All City Champs that played on ebbits field. He achieved MVP.

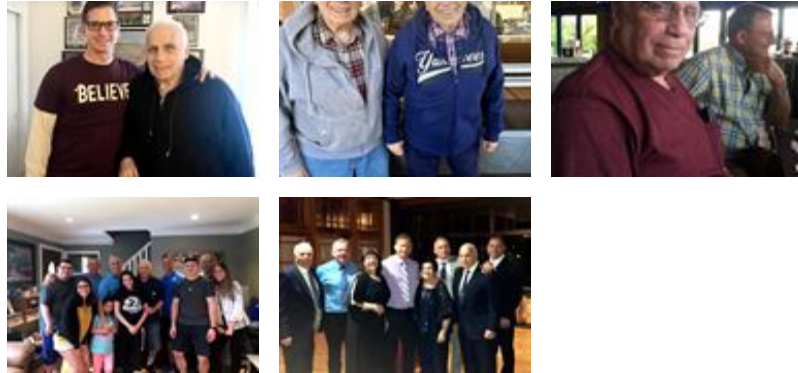
