October 25, 1934 - June 28, 2024

Anthony J. Giangrande, 89, of Eltingville, Staten Island, NY, passed away at his home on June 28, 2024.

Born on October 25, 1934, to loving parents Antonio and Vincenza (nee Omaccione) Giangrande of San Vittore de Lazio, Italy, Anthony and his family lived in Brooklyn, New York.

At the age of 21, Anthony became a New York City Police Officer and spent 28 years with the 9th and 61st Precincts in Brooklyn, NY. He also led a secondary career as armed security. He was honored by the New York City Police Department for his heroism, with one act standing out profoundly - his compassionate intervention in the life of a civilian in deep distress. Anthony's enduring empathy and strength touched countless lives in his career, and it was clear to all that he thrived in protecting his city and his family.

Anthony loved fishing, bowling, and participating in the NYPD softball league. He was also an avid sports fan of the New York Yankees, New York Giants and New York Knicks.

The beloved husband of the late Rosalie (nee Castagna), Anthony is survived by his brother, Carl Giangrande (Jane); children Steven (Lisa), Annette and Michele Giangrande; grandchildren Jennifer, Gianina, Stephanie (Kyle),

Joseph (Megan), Jessica, and Thomas; three great-grandchildren and one great-grandchild expected in August 2024. He is predeceased by his son, Michael Giangrande; and siblings Lawrence (Helen); Michael, Frank (Toby), Dolly, and Domenica. Anthony loved his family immensely and will be greatly missed by all.

Services will be held from 3:00 PM to 8:00 PM on Tuesday, July 2, 2024, and the funeral will be held on Wednesday, July 3 at 10:00AM at The John Vincent Scalia Home For Funerals in Staten Island, New York. Interment will be held at St. Charles Cemetery, Farmingdale, NY immediately following the funeral.

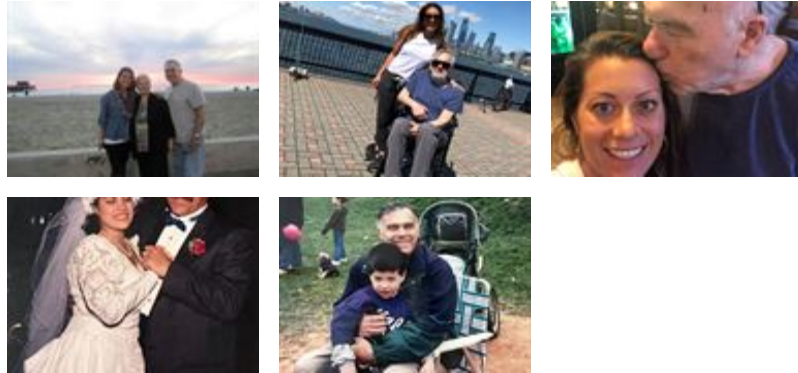
