



Anthony Trezza

July 8, 1932 - December 2, 2017

Anthony Trezza, 85, of Bulls Head passed away on Saturday, December 2, 2017 with his wife by his side. He was a loving husband, father of three, and grandfather of eight. Anthony was born on July 7, 1932 in Brooklyn, NY. He graduated from Harren High School in Manhattan and then served in the US Army in the Korean War in Germany. While serving, he was a member of the basketball and football teams and a player/coach with the baseball team. Anthony met his future wife, CarolAnn, in 1956, while vacationing in Florida. They married on November 2, 1957 and recently celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary surrounded by their children and grandchildren. After his marriage to CarolAnn, Anthony entered the Electronic Industry as a salesman utilizing his engineering education from Newark Engineering College, Rutgers University, and New York City Community College.

Volunteering was a large part of Anthony's life. He was the Chairman of the sports program at St. Adalbert's School from 1971-1980. He was also a past president of the parish council and a lector at mass. Anthony was a coach and an umpire in the Mid Island Little League. He also coached a high school CYO basketball team for many years.

Once his children graduated college and were moving forward with their careers, Anthony became an avid golfer. He combined his love for the game with numerous fundraising commitments. He co-chaired the Staten Island

Heart Association Golf Outing in 2000 and established the Shaun Hicks Men's Club Scholarship for NYC Junior Golfers. He served as the President of the Men's Club and also co-chaired their annual golf outing for many years.

Anthony dedicated the last 16 years of his life to The Drive for Autism Foundation where he served as a Trustee. He began the foundation with his son, Thomas, after learning that his grandson was diagnosed with Autism. The Drive for Autism Foundation has raised over \$650,000 to benefit schools on Staten Island and in New Jersey that serve children and adults who fall within the Autism spectrum.

Anthony is survived by his wife, CarolAnn; his children Karen Jean Feury and her husband, Tom, Lauren Garin and her husband, James, and Thomas Trezza and his wife, Tara; and his grandchildren Blaze, Jake, and Tess Feury, Matthew and Maggie Garin, and Casey, Ryan, and Patrick Trezza.
