He would wake and with his limited mobility due to stroke always found time to keep himself occupied appreciating each day till the sun went down. He never took no for an answer even when confronted with impossibilities he still found a way to overcome and fix them for use. He drove his car with his left instead of right foot and to use a spinner on the wheel instead of both hands so he can drive. When my mother his wife was very ill from cancer he would spend his time as her caretaker, helping her wash and comforting her through the pain she was enduring. After my mom passed he had to step in as the prime parent of his two sons who he helped raised until he had the stroke but once better continued for his one son Edward who needed a lot of care due to his emotional state...He never remarried and kept his true love in his heart and I hope he is with her now in peace and eternal love watching over me and my brother his family and all our extended families..
