“ I met Blaise 45 years ago while working at the Pacific Stock Exchange (PSE) in downtown Los Angeles. Blaise was in Data Communications and I customer service. During that time, PSE acquired corporate apartments in San Francisco directly across from Ghiradelli Square. We would come up with a reason to meet with the San Francisco Equities Floor staff for an early Monday morning meeting. We would fly up to San Francisco on a Friday eve on PSA Airlines and prepare for our Monday morning meeting by .. consuming many Irish Whiskies at the “Buena Vista”, Dining at Scoma’s, and hanging out in every bar in the San Francisco financial district.

Blaise and I became well known for writing and performing corporate songs that basically insulted all of our top management including the Chairman of PSE. We performed these, although not asked, at staff meetings, holiday parties, you name it...how we kept our jobs I will never know...

After work in LA, we would head to our favorite spot “Marcus Steakhouse” where we would meet for “Just One Drink”... Each St, Patrick’s day, starting at 10:00 am, we would head to Casey’s Bar & Grill for green beer... where the goal was to not fall off the barstool. I proudly still hold this title. With very little coaxing, Blaise would sing both the soprano and basso parts of “Some Enchanted Evening” – always a showstopper with absolute strangers applauding.

When Blaise moved back to NY, I recall during her job search that she called and said she had a job offer from Pepsi. She started the job on a Monday morning and the staff took her for a intro Lunch... Following lunch, Blaise excused herself and never went back again hahaha...

Blaise came to visit me in Las Vegas many times. She loved her Joker Poker and a good buffet. My joke was when she ordered Prime Rib so rare that I would tell her I had seen animals survive injuries like that.

Blaise was always full of stories about Caitlin and Allison who made her life so much richer. And now, Brenda, the baby of the family, moves forward with the her daughters and 4 grand children who will keep memories alive of “Auntie Blaise”.
