



## Brian J. McCoy

June 13, 1961 - July 14, 2015

STATEN ISLAND, N.Y. -- Former Staten Island resident Brian J. McCoy, 54, of Port Charlotte, Fla., a drywall finisher and dedicated volunteer who was devout in his faith, died July 14 at home.

Born in Brooklyn, he moved with his family to Annadale as a child. He relocated to Vero Beach, Fla., in 2010, and to Port Charlotte three months ago.

A Tottenville High School graduate, he worked as a drywall finisher and was a member of Local #1974 of District Council 9 of the International Union of Painters and Allied Trades. He later worked as a painter at Community Agency for Senior Citizens and Senior Housing Resource Corp., both on the Island.

Mr. McCoy was religious and attended Time Square Church, Manhattan, in addition to many other church and prayer groups.

He often volunteered at soup kitchens in Manhattan and delivered food to those in need on Staten Island.

An outdoorsman, he enjoyed hiking, fishing and hunting. He also enjoyed cycling, gardening and reading. He was also passionate about animals and

owned pet dogs.

He is survived by his parents, Constance L. and Robert Justus McCoy, and his sisters, Suzanne McCoy-Fitschen and Melissa C. McCoy.

A memorial mass is planned for Saturday at 11 a.m. in St. Patrick's R.C. Church, Richmond. Arrangements, including cremation, are being handled by the John Vincent Scalia Home for Funerals, Eltingville.
