Carmen Tripo, known to many by Carmine, passed away peacefully at home while under hospice care. He was 83 years old.

Carmen was born in Brooklyn, graduated from Manhattan University and served during the Vietnam era while in the Army. He married Patricia McNeil in 1970 and moved to Staten Island in 1979, where together they raised their four children.

Carmen was the Manager of the State Tax Department for Bristol-Myers Squibb, where he was employed for 34 years, retiring in 2004. He was an active member of the Holy Child Choir for over 40 years and also sang with the Richmond Choral Society. Carmen was a volunteer for Meals on Wheels, delivering meals on a weekly basis.

He and his wife of 55 years loved to travel and visited Rio de Janeiro, Machu Picchu, Buenos Aires, Italy, Croatia and many Caribbean Islands. The best place was Turks and Caicos where the entire family celebrated their 50th Wedding Anniversary.

Carmen is survived by his wife Patricia Tripo; his children, Thomas Tripo (Anna), Daniel Tripo (Erin), Kristen Bouzada (Peter) and Paul Tripo (Caitlin). He is also survived by his six grandchildren, Daniel, Ava, Charles, Michael,

Lucas and LucyAnne and his sister, Rosemary Gritz. In addition, he is survived by many nieces, nephews and cousins.
