November 28, 1930 - October 11, 2015

Longtime Pleasant Plains resident Catherine Moran, 84, a homemaker who most loved being with her children and grandchildren, died Sunday at home.

Born Catherine McGarvey in Brooklyn, she moved to Port Richmond with family when she was 3 years old. She also lived in Great Kills before settling in Pleasant Plains.

Mrs. Moran first worked as a switchboard operator for Consolidated Edison for five years. She then became a full-time homemaker, but also worked as an elementary school assistant at St. Joseph-St. Thomas School in Pleasant Plains from 1975 to 1980.

She was a member of the Ladies of the Great Kills Yacht Club.

Mrs. Moran was a dedicated wife, mother and grandmother, her family said.

She was fond of gardening, boating and using computers.

"She was very outgoing and fun to be with," said her son, Noel Jr. "She was straightforward and honest, and also very kind and caring."

Mrs. Moran was a parishioner of St. Joseph-St. Thomas R.C. Parish in her

community.

Her daughter, Kim Lizbeth Moran, died in 2012.

Surviving, along with her son, Noel Jr., are her husband of 63 years, Noel Sr.; her son, Brian; her daughter, Melissa Derenzi; her sisters, Mary Calvanese and Patricia Wolczananski, and four grandchildren.
