war movies and Christmas movies if they were telecaptioned. And above all, he loved spending time with his family particular playing with his nieces and nephews, great nieces and nephews, and eventually, great great nieces and nephews.

Charles was everyone's "Uncle Charlie". If you met him you instantly were impressed by his ability to make anyone feel like family. Nicknamed Mr. Christmas, he loved the season of Christmas, having an extensive collection of Christmas villages, trees and decorations that he had amassed for many years, some pieces given to him by his mother in the 1930's. Although he had quite a collection, he impressed upon everyone that the season of Christmas is a holy one where Christ's birth is celebrated first and foremost.

Charles is survived by numerous nieces, nephews, great nieces and nephews, and great great nieces and nephews- all of whom will miss him terribly.

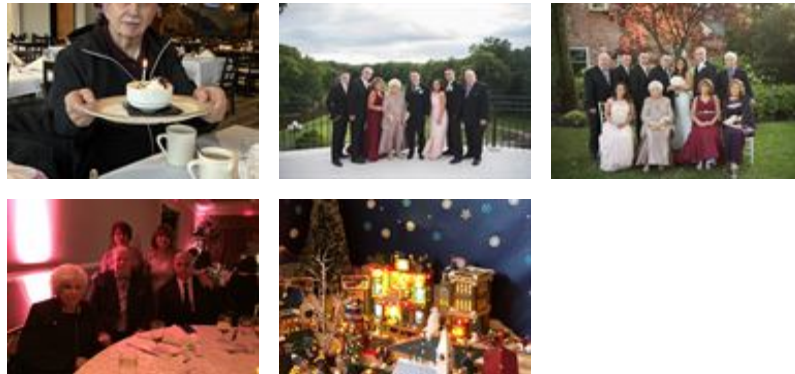
