Concetta "Connie" Fisher (nee DeMato) passed away on June 19, 2016. She was born on Franklin Avenue in New Brighton on June 26, 1932. Her parents, Nettie and Frank DeMato, Connie and brother, Michael, moved to Midland Beach in 1939.

Connie was an alumna of St. Margaret Mary's and New Dorp High School. She worked for the Hartford Insurance Company in Manhattan before meeting her husband, Bill, in 1956. They married in 1958 and were blessed with a daughter, Theresa Ann, in 1960. The family eventually settled in their home in Midland Beach in 1977.
