Lifelong Brooklyn resident, Dominick Lodispoto, 89, passed away on Saturday, April 20, 2019, at Eger Health Care & Rehab. Center in Staten Island.

Born Tuesday, December 24, 1929, he was the son of the late Joseph and Mary Lodispoto.

Dominick served honorably during the Korean Conflict in the United States Army from 1951 to 1953. He served overseas in Germany, achieving the rank of Private 2nd Class.

He was an avid card player, and loved taking frequent trips to Atlantic City and Las Vegas. He was quite the card player, especially at Rummy 500 and Black Jack, and continued to play cards up until his last days. He also enjoyed playing craps and roulette. Dominick was a service manager in heating and air conditioning by trade, and had hands of gold. He was quoted many times saying "there's nothing made that I can't fix". This held true throughout his life as he was always there to help everyone, whether it be for an air conditioning service call or a broken hot water heater - "Dom was there".

Above all, he was a devoted and loving father, grandfather and great grandfather, who truly cherished time spent with his family, whom he

treasured.

Dominick was predeceased by his beloved wife, Marie, who passed away in 1987. He was also predeceased by his son, Joseph, who passed away in 2013 and his brother, Jerry.

He was the loving father of Maria Parente and her husband Ron, Dominick Lodispoto and his wife, Fran and Gina Medina and her husband, Rodney. Dear brother of Frances Constantino and Joseph Lodispoto, Jr.; and devoted grandfather to his 11 grandchildren and 7 great grandchildren.
