Up until a few months ago she was still continuing to read Biographies and pressing flowers. Mrs. Vaccaro also made her own maternity clothes and clothing for her children. My mother used to make us Halloween costumes, she even made them for her grandchildren. Besides all her accolades she had a gift and love for gardening. She helped many of her nieces with her knowledge and gardening skills.

Above all, she will be remembered for being a Loving and dedicated Mother, Mother-in-Law and Grandmother. My mothers love for us was unmatched; her children and grandchildren will always be her most amazing accomplishments. She loved us all beyond. We were everything to her and she was our most precious assets. Our love for her will be eternal. I will miss her my whole life; she was everything to my family and I. We are at a great loss in our lives, but I know she was greeted by her beautiful Gracie when she entered Heaven on Valentines Day.
