Fannie (Fortunata) Ingrassi, 85, passed away on December 7, 2017 at her residence surrounded by her loving family.

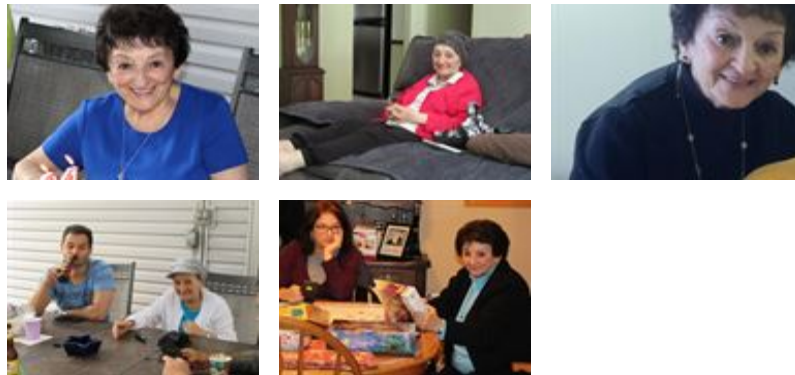

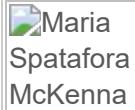
