Frank Rapacciuolo, 83 of Huguenot, passed away on Sunday, October 6, 2019, at his home surrounded by his loving family.

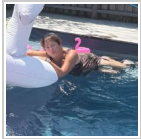

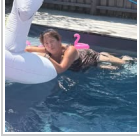
