Frederick Anthony Deighan, 79, passed away peacefully on April 4, 2017 at his home surrounded by his loving family.

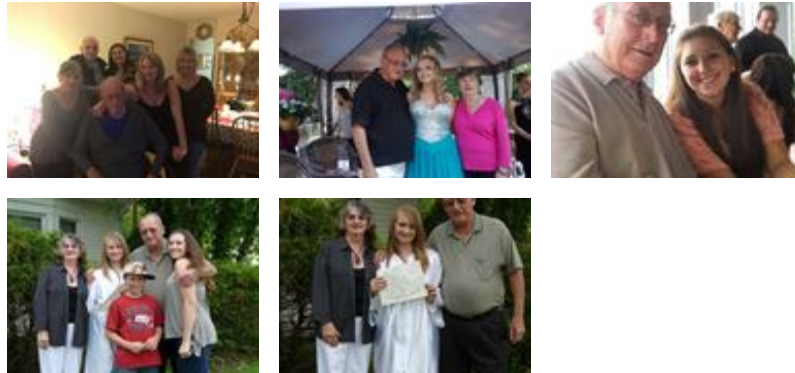
