Beloved father, grandfather and brother George Strype passed away on February 26, 2026. He was 85 years old.

George was born on August 12, 1940 in Brooklyn NY to Richard and Margaret (Magee) Strype. He was raised in Bay Ridge, Brooklyn with his fourteen siblings. George graduated from Fort Hamilton High School and then served his country in the US Army. After being honorably discharged he joined the New York City Sanitation Department. 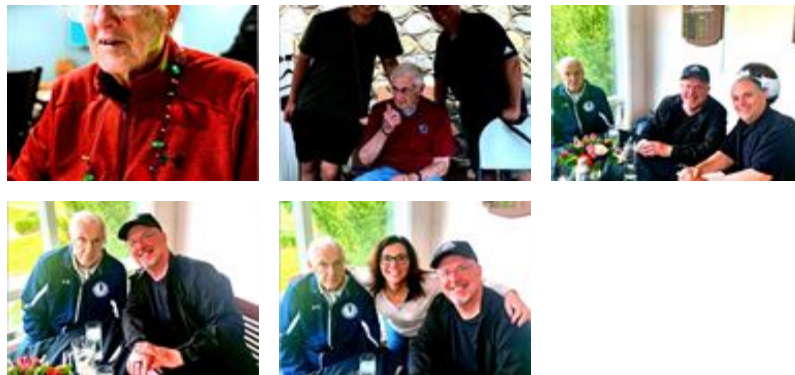

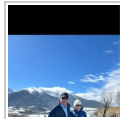
