George W. Weir, III, 62, passed away on Friday, November 8, 2019, at Adventhealth Cancer Institute in Daytona Beach, Florida.

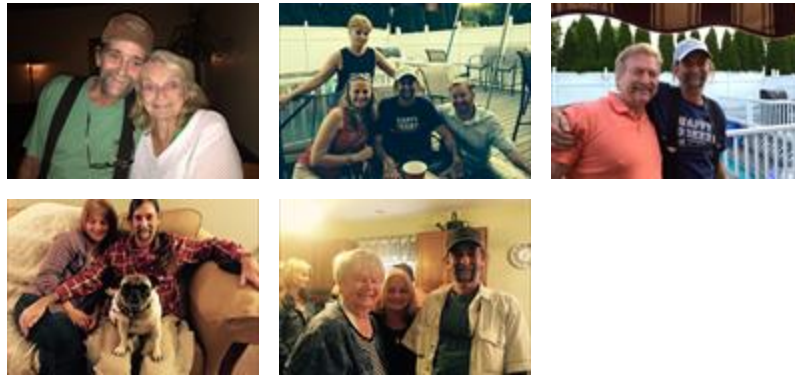
