“ *The Gina that I know was nearly 9 years old when I met her. I remember being at the Crescitelli house one evening when I was about 15. I was with my oldest sister, and we were picking up Jimmy---Gina's oldest brother---to go to the movies. Gina and her brother Tony were so sweet, wondering who this visitor was. Lois was also there, of course, but not so visible.*

Gina was beautiful. It was Gina who agreed to get dressed up and to serve all of Jimmy's guests on July 31, 1976, at his Southern-style outdoor Bicentennial party.

I got to see Gina in person mostly on sadder occasions, after that---at Mr. Crescitelli's wake, as well as at wakes for other Crescitelli family members. But Gina never changed, though, apart from the fact that she had become a young woman. I even remember Jimmy's stories about her and himself, when they traveled to Italy one year and met all the relatives.

I'm so grateful to have some of the digital photos of her from happier times. I'm also grateful that any difficulties and challenges that she had in later life are over, and that she's safe now.

I'll always remember Gina as she was when I first met her. That's the Gina that I know.
