Gregory L. Owen, 63, passed away suddenly and unexpectedly on April 6, 2018. Born on Staten Island, he graduated from Susan Wagner High School and The College of Staten Island. He taught high school biology in several schools in Brooklyn and New Jersey before spending most of his teaching career at Curtis High School. He also worked part time as an adjunct at Kingsboro Community College.

Gregory had a passion for antiques and bought and sold items, especially antique radios, as a hobby. He also arranged estate sales. He was a talented pianist, enjoyed improvising, and played with several jazz and rock bands. Locally he was famous for his St. Patrick's Day parties, where he would feed all comers in his front yard near the parade route. An animal lover, he owned numerous animals – most recently a cocker spaniel, Harley.

Gregory was a devoted parishioner of several parishes on Staten Island including Our Lady Star of the Sea, Sacred Heart, and most recently, Our Lady Help of Christians. He is survived by his son, John G., his father, John M., his sister, Heidi, his brother, Stephen and his wife, Anne Marie. He was formerly married to Doreen Belloni.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be offered at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday at Our Lady Star of the Sea Church located at 5411 Amboy Rd Staten Island, New

York 10312. Interment will follow in Resurrection Cemetery, Staten Island, NY.
