In his career as a social worker, Uncle championed services for anyone under his charge requiring a home, care or assistance.

He is survived by his nephew Peter Manetti and wife Denise, his nieces Arlene Manetti and Loraine Maniscalco, his godson Eric Gunderson and wife Teresa , and all his great nieces and nephews.

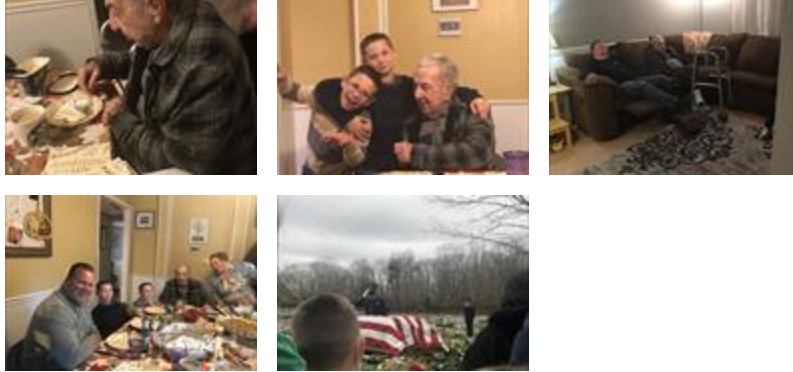

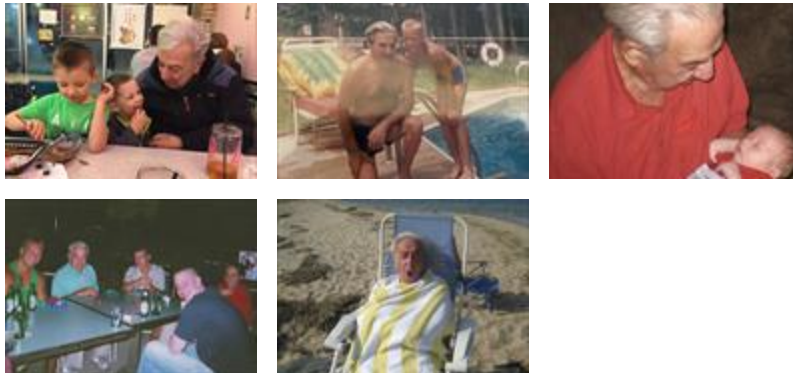

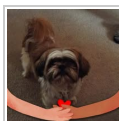
