Harry R. Bolten, 82 of Great Kills, died on Tuesday, September 22, 2015, at Staten Island University Hospital North in Staten Island, New York.

He served in the United States Air Force from 1953 until 1957 during the Korean Conflict. and was a parishioner of St. Clare Church.
