“ Keeping 5 kids entertained on a hot summer day took lots of planning on mom's part. Many days she'd take us to Coney Island to play in the sand and surf. But getting 5 kids dressed for the beach and bringing enough food along to feed us all took half the morning. Money was tight and buying lunch for 5 kids was out of the question but mom had it all planned and together every single time! As soon as we got to Coney Island and picked out our spot on the beach, mom went to work securing the two youngest - which was Elaine and I to make sure we didn't wander off and get lost. Now this may sound barbaric or even be called child abuse today but she would tie a rope around Elaine's waist that had a lead of about 8 to 10 feet (much like a dog leash) then tie the other end of the rope to one of the big mesh garbage pails on the beach. Then with a 2nd long rope she'd do the same to me. We sure as heck never got lost and mom always knew where we were. Then one at a time she'd carry us to the water, walking into the waves, swimming with us clutching onto her for dear life. Then when we were all worn out and hungry she'd pull out a big jug that held about half a gallon of water - all prepared with lunch! Mom would fill the big jug at home with boiling water and add enough hot dogs to feed herself and 5 hungry children. She'd take a hot dog bun out of her beach bag, use a fork to stab a hot dog out of the jug, and we'd each wait our turn for a hot dog. Best beach lunch ever! Then after an exhausting day it was time to leave but mom didn't want a car full of sand

She'd wrap a towel around us, instruct us to hold it up while she'd take off our wet, sandy wet suit and put shorts on us. Inevitably, somebody would drop their towel! The most excitement was yet to come...Elaine and I were allowed to chose only one ride each before going home.

Mom would remind us, only one ride. That's all I have money for so choose wisely and no crying when it's over. Of course, we cried for a second ride every time but were reminded...only enough money for one ride each. And a day or two later we'd do it all again!

You have no idea, my beautiful mom, the amazing memories you created for us from all the wonderful times we shared together! Memories lasting a lifetime while filling our hearts with respect for

you, along with joy and love we'd never forget! While it's so hard to let you go, mom, the fun and love you showed and taught us will forever be in our hearts.

I have but one request of you: until we meet again in God's kingdom please love, teach and take care of my 2 baby girls who never had a chance at the beautiful life I had with you. Always and forever in my heart Mom's ❤️
