James Quinn, 84 of Great Kills, passed away on Friday, August 18, 2017, at Richmond University Medical Center in Staten Island, surrounded by his loving family.

James was born in Brooklyn and moved to Great Kills in 1969. He was a graduate of St. James High School. He served in the United States Army from 1956-1958, stationed primarily in Germany. He then worked for 20 years in the printing industry in Manhattan in the print production management field at many city newspapers. His industry expertise led him to design and conduct print production classes for industry employees at the New York School of Printing.

James earned both his Bachelors Degree and his Masters Degree in Education from the City College of NY. In 1984, he started working as a full time member of the NYC College of Technology, where he remained for over 30 years. In 1998, he was inducted into the "Who's Who" in Professionals". He also served as a consultant to Empire State College, and conducted in service courses for the Department of Education and also served as an examination administrator for high school teaching positions.

James was a member of the Knights of Columbus and the Ancient Order of Hibernians. He especially enjoyed traveling to Ireland, Rome, Alaska, Hawaii

and many Caribbean islands with his wife, Barbara.
