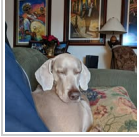

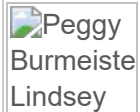

“ I wanted to share a story about my friend Janet. She was the parent coordinator at Tommy's school. She was the first person I met when touring The Hungerford School sites. Her smile and personality made us feel comfortable right away. She was a perfect representative of the Hungerford School. She was a parent of a child with special needs as well. She was one of "us". She knew and understood the ups and downs of our special "club".

On one of the first few days of Tommy attending his new school I had to drive him. It was Tommy, Abbey and I (Abbey was 6 at the time). A little FYI, Tommy NEVER gets out of the car for me going to any school so I knew it was going to be difficult. They let me bring him in the side door because he was having a major meltdown in the parking lot. Laying on the ground, punching the cinder block walls, screaming and crying and biting himself. Security had to come and help us, along with a few staff members. Janet came and whisked Abbey away and brought her into her office so she wouldn't have to witness what was going on with her brother. After Tommy finally went in, I sat on the floor and cried. Along comes Janet with Abbey and Abbey has a Hungerford fleece on (way too big where it reached almost the floor) and a bunch of items in her hands - little toys and jewelry that Janet had in her office. I got up and hugged her and thanked her for doing that. It meant so much.

Everyday after that, when I would pick up Tommy from school, Abbey would run to Janet's office and they would talk and laugh. In their own words they were "BFFs". As Abbey got older (she is now 10), they would sit on the stairs in the hallway of the school and have what Janet used to call "stoop time". They would have their little talks about life and sports and of course the chickens! They gave each other gifts all the time - handmade and whatnot. Abbey and Janet would always be together whether it was while decorating for the holiday fair, or if Abbey had to come to a PA meeting. They had a special friendship.

Janet helped me in so many ways at the school, especially when I

became a member of the PTA/PA. She was such a help and a voice of reason and also a real comedian. We would swap stories of the crazy events that happen in the world of special needs parents and would often end up having side splitting belly laughs. A wonderful person and a wonderful soul. She left us with so many memories. I will cherish the time I got to spend with her and I thank God that he put our paths together. Rest in peace my friend AND Abbey's BFF. You will be sorely missed!

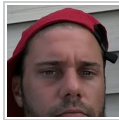
