Jean R. Pagel (nee Lukaszewski) passed away on November 18, 2017.

A native New Yorker, born and raised in Brooklyn, Jean attended the then, St. Mary's (Hospital) School of Nursing, where she earned her RN credential, continued on to earn both her Bachelor and Master of Science in Nursing Degrees on full scholarships, from St. John's University, Queens, New York.

Jean was one of the four original "founders" of the Nursing Department at what was then, Staten Island Community College, and went on to teach for more than forty years at The College of Staten Island; her "signature" course was Child Health Nursing. Jean's native intelligence was exceeded only by her marvelous spirit of empathy ofr nurising students, and the daunting challenges they faced. Jean's ability and facility to communicate both science and art of nursing, made her "beloved" of her students.

In 1968 Jean married Dr. Paul R. Pagel, and they lived their life together in the Lighthouse Hill area of Staten Island.

Jean was preceeded in death by her mother, Anna, father, Matthew, and elder sisters, Dolores and Anna Mae. She is survived by her husband, Paul, and sister and brother-in-law, Irene and Frank DeNave of Waretown, NJ, and sister-in-law, Roseann and brother Matthew Lukaszewski of Prescott, Arizona.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be offered on Wednesday at 10:00 a.m. at St. Patrick's Church, located at 53 St. Patrick's Place, SI. Interment will follow in Green-Wood Cemetery, Brooklyn.
