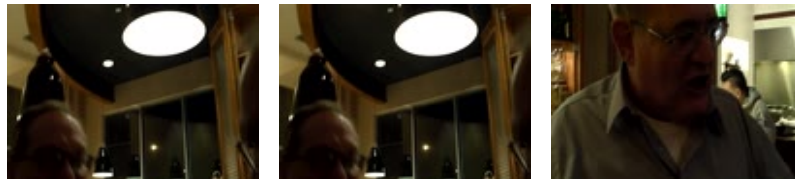

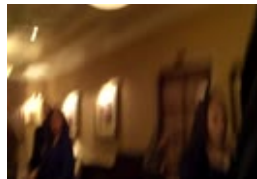

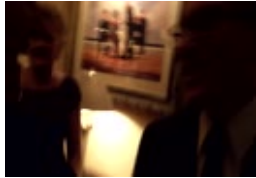

“ Hey Jer,

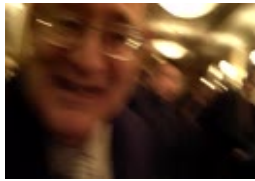
