John P. McTigue, of Great Kills, passed away on February 19, 2024 at the age of 89 surrounded by his family at Staten Island University North Hospital.

He graduated from La Salle High School and received his B.S. in Civil Engineering from City College. In 1969, he and his young family settled in Great Kills.
