



Joseph V. Arleo

Joseph V. Arleo, 85, of Eltingville, an Army veteran and a loving husband, father and grandfather, died Friday in Addeo Hospice Residence, Egbertville.

Born in the Little Italy section of Manhattan, Mr. Arleo moved to Brooklyn after his marriage in 1955, and to Eltingville in 1991.

An alumnus of Seward Park High School, Manhattan, he was a carpenter at Matzkin Bros., in the Bronx, for 22 years, before becoming a shop foreman for Koslow Store Front Company, Brooklyn, where he worked for 19 years. He retired in 1995.

He served in the U.S. Army in Panama and Greenland during the Korean War era.

Mr. Arleo played softball, enjoyed bowling and loved horse racing and going to the track.

As a child, he was a member of The James Center, Manhattan.

He was a parishioner of Holy Child R.C. Church, Eltingville. Mr. Arleo was a member of the Mount Loretto Friendship Club.

"What was most important to him was his family," said his daughter, Joanne Cronin. "Basically, everything he did his whole life was for all of us."

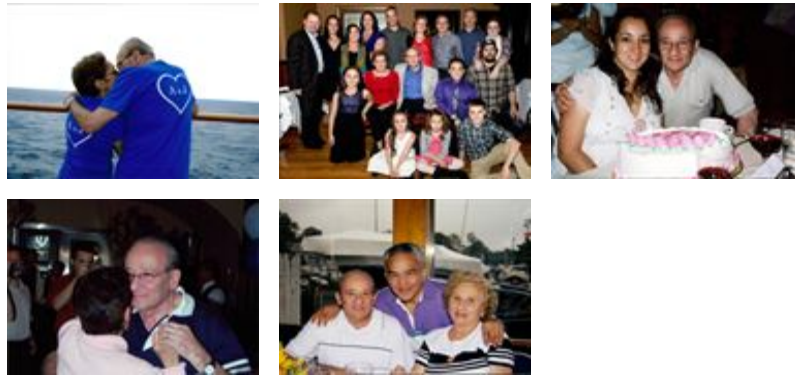
