Joseph Martino (84) of Staten Island, NY passed away peacefully on February 12, 2017 at Wilkes Barre VA Medical, Wilkes Barre, PA surrounded by his children and granddaughter.

Joseph was born in Brooklyn, NY to Gaetano (Tom) Martino and Josephina (Mignosi) Martino on May 18, 1932. In addition to being a Certified Mechanic for over 40 years, Joseph was a Golden Gloves Champion in the Middleweight Division while stationed at Reece Air Force Base in Lubbock, TX. He fought 3 professional fights before he retired. He was a veteran of The Korean War and served in the Air Force as an Airman First Class, and was awarded United States Service Medal, National Defense Service Medal and the Korean Service Medal.

Joseph always felt his children were his biggest achievements in life and enjoyed being with them and his grandchildren every chance he had. He loved to cook, attend sporting events and will always be known and loved for his great story telling ability. He was extremely proud to be a Veteran of the United States and loved his country.

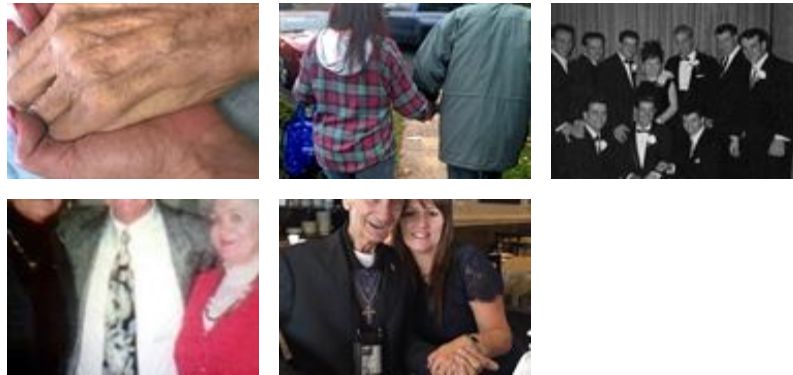

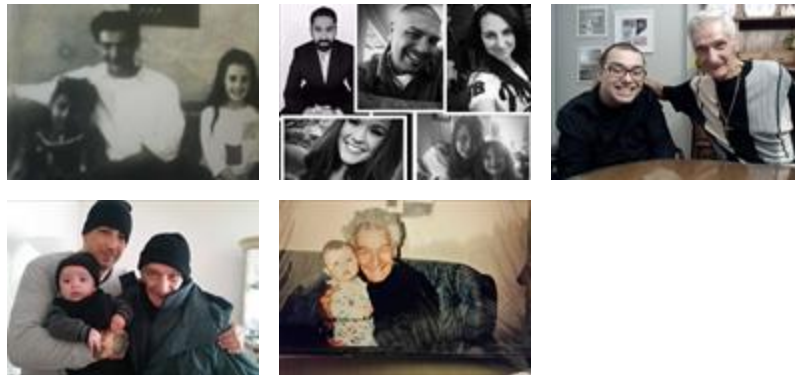
