Kathleen Joan Judge Dodd of Staten Island, N.Y. passed away peacefully with family by her side on April 24, 2021, one day after her 75th birthday.

Kathy was born to Thomas Joseph Judge and Dina Miller Judge on April 23, 1946 in the Bronx. In 1954 the family moved to Wantagh, NY, where she attended and graduated from General Douglas MacArthur High School. She earned her Bachelor's Degree in Education from S.U.N.Y Oswego. Then she earned her Master's Degree in Liberal Studies from S.U.N.Y Stony Brook.

Kathy was an elementary school teacher before marrying Phillip North Dodd on July 16, 1970, in Wantagh, NY. Freshly married and ready for a new adventure, Phillip and Kathy moved to Denver Colorado for a year. They then moved to Queens before purchasing a home in Village Greens in Arden Heights, Staten Island, in 1974. This is the home where the couple had their four children.

Kathy was dedicated to the community where they lived. She was actively involved in her community serving as President of the Village Greens Residents Association.
