Laurence (Larry) Liguori, 86 of Brooklyn, New York, passed away on Saturday, April 11th in Brooklyn, New York.

One of eight children of Lillian and Joseph Liguori, Larry and his siblings Gene, Joseph, Helen, Ted, Vincent, Paul and Rita grew up in the Kensington section of Brooklyn, the borough he called home for his entire life.

Larry attended St. Rose of Lima Elementary School, Erasmus High School and NY University where he obtained Bachelors, Masters and Dentistry Degrees. A practicing dentist for 55 years, Larry was the type of selfless and compassionate dentist who was always available for his patients.

Larry was also an accomplished singer with an repertoire that began in the St. Rose of Lima choir launching a storied career that included summer performances in the Catskills, weekly appearances on Paul Whiteman Show in Philadelphia, hundreds of weddings and other celebrations culminating with a starring role in a Broadway show called Mob Hits where Larry's rich baritone was an instant hit.

Larry's third "profession" was that of a gourmet cook whose passion for cooking extended to his entire family. Countless dinners and deserts were a central part of family gatherings which always brought us around the table to

celebrate and cherish our family.

Larry is survived by his siblings, Rita, Helen and Paul and his nieces, nephews and their spouses Lauren and James, Michael and Susan, Karen and John as well as his "grand" nieces and nephews, Caitlin, Michael, Leah and John.

The love that Larry had for his family and friends was a gift to all who knew him.
