Linda was a second mother to so many young children in our closely knit group of families. She brought joy and caring to everyone she knew and made the best pizza ever.

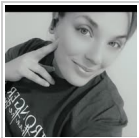
We will cherish those happy times and be forever grateful for Lidia to have blessed us with her love, devotion and zest for life.

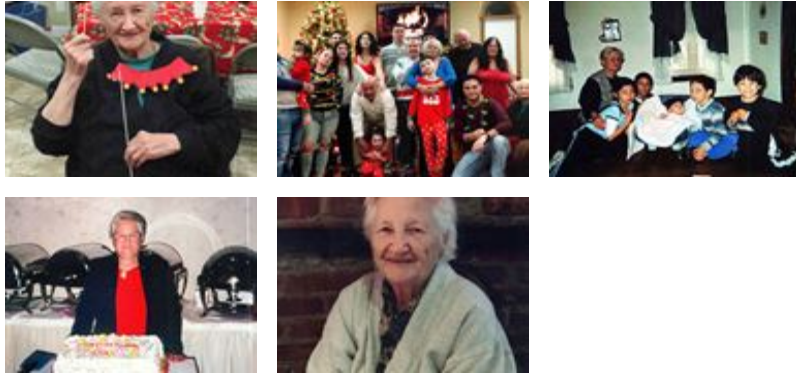
