Lido Millares, 87, passed away on Sunday, August 11, 2024, after a prolonged battle with his health. While we mourn his loss, we take comfort in knowing his suffering has ended and he is now at peace. We would like to honor his memory by sharing some stories and experiences he cherished most.

Lido dedicated over 25 years of his life to his work at Paper Industries Corporation of the Philippines (P.I.C.O.P.), which was Asia's largest company at the time. Not only did he love the company itself, but he was also grateful for its proximity to Zenaida's, his beloved wife's, home. His enthusiasm for life was evident in his active participation in various activities, including playing basketball and taking part in events like the "Mystery Singer" competition, where he won a leather jacket. Lido's deep connection to P.I.C.O.P. and the joy he found in both his work and the company community were a testament to his vibrant spirit and love for life.

After retiring from P.I.C.O.P., Lido Millares continued his passion for service by assisting a close family friend in their congressional campaign. His efforts paid off, and the candidate won the position, securing Lido a full-term position as Chief of Staff for the congressman representing the 2nd district of Surigao del Sur. For nine years, he thrived in this role, where he not only managed the office but also crafted speeches, a task he particularly enjoyed. His time in Congress was marked by dedication and pride, as he found great fulfillment in

contributing to the legislative process and supporting his community.

At the age of 64, Lido Millares immigrated to the United States with Zenaida, embarking on a new chapter of their lives. Despite his age, Lido continued to work with the same dedication and drive that had defined his earlier years, securing a position at Citibank. Over the course of eight years, he rose to become the nationwide highest-ranking Accountant and Vice President, a testament to his unwavering work ethic and commitment. Finally retiring at 72, Lido embraced his passion for travel alongside the love of his life, Zenaida. Together, they visited many destinations, with their most cherished memories being their three pilgrimages to Jerusalem and Medjugorje. These sacred journeys allowed them to deepen their connection with their faith, as they walked in the footsteps of Jesus, visiting the sites of His birth and His journey on the cross.

Lido Millares will always be remembered for his boundless love for life, his infectious laughter, and his unwavering dedication to his family-his beloved wife, Zenaida, his six children, Arne Jude, LZ Marie, Liduvino Jr., Augusto, Dodgie, and Ivan, as well as his 16 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren. He was truly gifted with a large and loving family, and his life was a testament to the deep care and commitment he had for each one of them. Lido's legacy of hard work, deep faith, and love for adventure will continue to inspire all who knew him, and his memory will forever be cherished.
