Lillian F. Keane, 101, passed away peacefully on July 12, 2016 at her home surrounded by her loving family.

She was born and raised on the upper West Side of Manhattan, after which she and her family of seven moved to Jackson Heights, Queens. After spending summers in Camp Ideal, South Beach, they grew to love Staten Island and in 1952, her husband built her the home that she loved until her death.

Her strong faith and love of God saw her through many trials, but she faced them always with a smile. Her dedication to her family, friends and neighbors earned her a reputation of generosity and compassion.

At age 31, Lillian worked first as a switchboard operator and later as Secretary to the Vice President of Greystone Publishing Company. She was chosen as "Outstanding Personality" and was an inspiration to every Greystoner. After they closed, she worked at Jansen and Rogan, studied the computer in her 70's and performed as a full-time worker until the age of 76 and then a part-time worker until she turned 82.

Predeceased by her husband, James, Lillian was the center of her family and she was very proud of her irish heritage and was always the life of the party at family celebrations.

Lillian was the devoted mother of her loving children, Marjorie Pugliese, Patrick James Keane, Michael D. Keane and Eileen Molinelli.
