“ Friends and family,

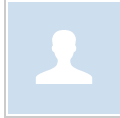

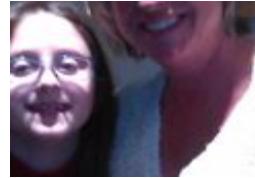
