Lisbeth Masseria, 68, of Staten Island, New York, passed away on August 30th, 2025, in her home.

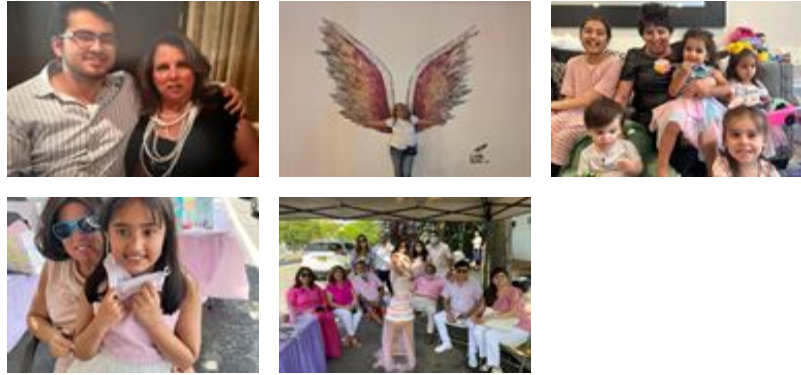
