Loving Husband, Brother, Father, and Grandfather, Louis Dujmich, 69, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by his family on January 25, 2026. His life was taken too soon by pancreatic cancer, which he faced with his characteristic strength.

A life-long Staten Islander, Lou grew up on Lighthouse Hill. He attended St. Patrick's School and Monsignor Farrell HS, where he graduated as valedictorian. He went on to college in Manhattan at The Cooper Union where he studied electrical engineering, followed by law school at Fordham University - where he was salutatorian.

Lou worked as a patent attorney for many years in the city. He started his career at Kenyon & Kenyon and ended it at Ostrolenk Faber, where he was a partner until his retirement in 2018. He lived in Huguenot with his cherished family. Lou was known for his countless talents, unique interests, and unwavering principles. Above all other hobbies, Lou's favorite passion was restoring antique automobiles. His first restoration was a 1930 Ford Model A when he was just 16 years old. He last completed a 1937 Ford Phaeton, which recently won best in show. He could fix anything. He enjoyed completing the NY Times crossword puzzle daily and loved spending time at the beach on Long Island in the summers with family and friends.

He is survived by his wife of 35 years, Mary, his children Daniel (Nina) and Melanie (Alistair), brother Carl (Cathy), and granddaughter Vivienne.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 AM on Saturday, January 31st, Our Lady Star of the Sea Church. Interment will be in Moravian Cemetery.
