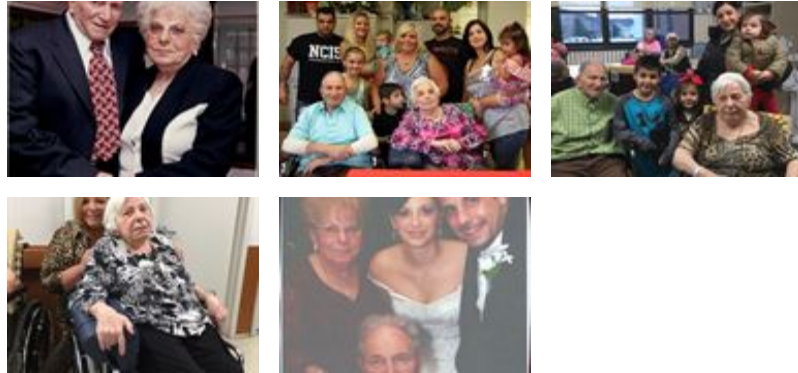
You played a major role in my life "Wallen" and I will miss you!
