Margie was one of the first and only moms on her beloved 59th St to get a job working outside the home. She took great pride in this accomplishment working near Wall St for J.P. Morgan for over 15 years, only once in that time did she misplace \$15 million for a few hours.

Margie loved listening to country music, Dolly Parton and Garth Brooks among her favorites. You could also find her deep in the latest Danielle Steel or Mary Higgins Clark books, but her favorite thing to do was watching her Hallmark Christmas movies, often turning down invitations to dinner (never bingo) if a new movie was debuting that night.

Margie had a gentle soul and an easygoing spirit and was a quick friend to everyone she met. She will be missed by all who were fortunate enough to know her. Her spirit will live on in her family, especially any time one of them yells, "Bingo!"
