Maryann T. Mugge, 74, of Eltingville, who most loved being with her family, died Saturday while visiting family in Ann Arbor, Michigan.

Born and raised in Brooklyn, she graduated St. Brendan's High School, in her native borough.

Mrs. Mugge worked as an Administrative Assistant for Chase Manhattan Bank until deciding to stay home and raise her growing family, in 1976.

Maryann met Harry Mugge on a blind date arranged by her cousin and his best friend, and it was love at first sight for the couple. They met in March, were engaged in July, and wed in August of 1971. They lived together in Eltingville for 39 years, until Harry's passing in 2015.

While raising her family she took time to complete an associate degree in liberal arts at CSI. After many years of being a stay-at-home mom, Maryann chose to start her career as a teacher's aide at St. Charles School, Oakwood. Maryann spent 30 years helping shape countless lives of children who attended St. Charles, she was fondly known as "Miss Maryann."

"She was loved by all who knew her, made everyone feel special, and will be missed beyond measure," her children explained.

Mrs. Mugge was happiest when she was with her family and doted on her grandchildren. She also enjoyed gardening and traveling with her family.

Mrs. Mugge attended Holy Child Church, Eltingville.

Surviving are her three children, Christopher Mugge, Jennifer Boyer, and Suzanne Provenzano, and her beloved grandchildren Jonathan, Michael, Juliana, Emily, Theodore, and Benjamin.
